**IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT CLASSES**

- Please note there are classes for Sr (Senior) and Jr (Junior) divisions. In the WNYDA CHALLENGE SERIES of Shows, a **Junior is age 21 and under and Senior is over 21 years of age**
- If you have special requests as to how you want to be scheduled (back to back rides or as far apart as possible) please state on entry. We will try to accommodate requests, but no promises.

**ENTRIES**

Please use the WNYDA CHALLENGE SERIES ENTRY FORM included in this Omnibus.

Classes are \$15.00 each. Make checks payable to **Houghton College** for entry fees and stabling (if desired). Non-WNYDA members must pay a \$10.00 non-member fee with a separate check made payable to WNYDA – or better deal: JOIN WNYDA and there will be no extra fee at any of the Challenge Series shows! You can join WNYDA by sending in a membership form (found in this Omnibus and \$45 membership fee made payable to WNYDA on a separate check accompanied with your entry form). **Mail checks to the Secretary** with your completed and signed entry form along with a copy of a 2009/2010 Negative Coggins and a copy of a Rabies Certificate valid within one year of the competition date and signed by a veterinarian. Please enclose a self-addressed envelope or **e-mail** for ride times.

**AWARDS**

Each class will have six ribbons per class. Rider scores may count toward Year End WNYDA Challenge Series Awards if the rider is a current WNYDA member at the time the scores are earned. Minimum score requirements and eight (8) volunteer hours are necessary to qualify for the year-end awards.

---

**FOOTING AND ARENAS**

All tests will be ridden in a small dressage arena – indoors – if weather is good, competition may be moved to outdoor sand ring. If indoors, V, S, R, P are posted in the shorter arena.

---

**STABLING**

Limited stabling available. Box stalls with doors on grounds. \$30.00 per stall includes initial sawdust or wood pellet bedding. Send stabling fees with entry form in check made payable to **Houghton College**. Wash rack with hot and cold water available.

---

**ATTIRE**

Boots, breeches and ASTM helmets are required for all competitors / riders. Boots and helmets required whenever mounted.

**DIRECTIONS**

---

**From Rochester** go south on route 390 to Mt. Morris. At the light at the end of the exit ramp, turn left. Follow route 408 through town (left at the light at the top of the slope, one SHORT block, and right at the next light) to Nunda. At the 4-way stop in Nunda, turn right on route 436. Follow it to the end on route 19-A. (As you reach the end of route 436 you will come down a fairly long steep slope, cross the Genesee River and bear right at the YEILD sign – it is only about ¼ mile from there to route 19-A.) Turn left on 19-A, go south about 14 miles, through the town of Fillmore. At the blinking yellow light in Fillmore the route # changes to 19. Continue straight 4 more miles through the town of Houghton. At the south end of Houghton look for purple sign with gold letters on the right the says “Houghton College Equestrian Center” on the near corner and a green street sign with white letters that says “Tucker Hill Road”. Turn right up Tucker Hill Road for 9/10 of a mile. Look for another purple and gold sign that says “Houghton College Equestrian Center”. About 50 feet past the sign, turn right on School Farm Road. Follow School Farm road to the end. The indoor arena and horse barns are to the right.

**From Buffalo** go south on route 400 to route 16 south. At the traffic light in Yorkshire Corners, turn left on route 39 east. Follow route 39 for 4 miles into Arcade. At the last traffic light in Arcade, turn right on route 98 south. About 6 miles out of Arcade the route number changes to route 243 (route 98 makes a right turn to go to Farmersville, but YOU stay STRAIGHT on route 243). Continue on route 243 to the end at the blinking light in Caneadea. Turn right on to route 19 north, go 3 miles. At the south end of Houghton, about 50’ past the 35MPH sign, turn left (west) up Tucker Hill Road. (purple and gold sign on corner under apple tree says “Houghton College Equestrian Center, 1 mile). Then turn right on School Farm Road just 50’ past another purple & gold sign that says “Houghton College Equestrian Center”. At the end of the road (3/4 mile) bear right to the indoor arena and horse barns.

**From the South, East or West** get off the Southern Tier Expressway (route 17/ I-86) at exit 30. Follow route 19 north for 14 miles. At the south end of Houghton, about 50’ past the 35MPH sign, turn left (west) up Tucker Hill Road, come 1 mile, turn right on School Farm Road. Come in to the end, bear right to the indoor arena and horse barns.
