Submit this form along with your volunteer hours form, rider achievement award report (if applicable) and copies of fronts of tests clearly showing score and Judge's signature. Scores must have been earned between October 1, 2010 and September 30, 2011. Challenge Series Show scores count for the WNYDA Challenge Series awards and the Flying Change Horse of the Year Award (if required USEF/USDF scores are also earned) and the Upstate GMO Schooling Show Achievement award if additional score requirements from a 2nd participating GMO are also received. Only scores from USEF/USDF Recognized Competitions count toward awards for Rider Achievement, Horse of the Year, Rider of the Year, Joint Upstate High Point and Flying Change Horse of the Year (if required Challenge Series scores are also earned) with at least one of the scores submitted from a WNYDA Sponsored Recognized Competition. Breeding Division score must be from a USDF Dressage Sport Horse Breed Show and horse must have been shown at the WNYDA Paduka Run Breed Show. Scores from classes restricted in any way i.e. Breed, Novice, etc. should not be submitted. Please review the WNYDA Awards Program Criteria in your Omnibus for details regarding score requirements for each of the above listed awards categories.
