IMPORTANT NOTES ABOUT CLASSES

- Please note there are classes for Sr (Senior) and Jr (Junior) divisions. In the WNYDA CHALLENGE SERIES of Shows, a junior is age 21 and under and Senior is over 21 years of age. **Please note Jr or Sr on your entry form.**
- **All classes will be run in order of progression with no exceptions.**
- All Intro Level tests will be ridden in the small arena. All Training Level tests may be ridden the small arena also if needed for scheduling purposes. All First Level & above tests will be ridden the large arena.

ENTRIES

- Please use the **WNYDA CHALLENGE SERIES ENTRY FORM available on the WNYDA website**
- Classes are \$18.00 each. With a \$10.00 Office Fee. Make entry checks payable to **Fox Run Equestrian LLC**. Non-WNYDA members must pay a \$15.00 non-member fee. The non-membership check must be made payable to **WNYDA** and **must accompany** the check for the class fees. Mail check(s), entry form(s), a copy of a Negative 2019/2020 Coggins, a copy of current Rabies, & **WNYDA Membership Card** to the **Secretary**.
- Please use a separate entry form for each horse/rider combination. Even if the horse has more than one rider & even if rider is riding more than one horse.
- Please **enclose a readable email address** on entry form. Times will be emailed on or before the Wednesday before the show.

AWARDS

Each class will have six ribbons per class. Rider scores for classes 1-11 may count toward Year End WNYDA Challenge Series Awards if the rider is a current WNYDA member at the time the scores are earned. (Please note a minimum score requirements and 8 volunteer hours are necessary to qualify for the year-end awards).

Donated prizes will also be available for High Scores, Team Competition and many other classes.

FOOTING, ARENAS AND STABLING

- All tests will be ridden in the outdoor sand ring
- Warm-up area will be the Indoor arena.
- Very limited stabling is available. Stalls will be \$25/day or \$30/night before & day of show. Stalls have doors and they are located on the grounds but **do not come with bedding** so bring your own or bedding can be purchased for \$10/bag Please include stall fee, stabling requests, and bedding orders w/payment with entry. (please note bedding payment can done upon arrival also.) Stalls must be cleaned before departure.
- For those arriving the evening before the show please note horses will not be permitted before 4:00 pm.
- Schooling in the outdoor arena will be permitted from 4:00pm – 7:30pm the evening before the show weather permitting.

ATTIRE

Show attire is preferred, however, casual attire is acceptable. An example of casual riding attire is a sleeved conservative shirt tucked in, riding pants, boots, and an approved hard hat. Also, horses must have approved tack for Recognized Competition. Boots & helmets required whenever mounted.

MANAGEMENT NOTES

Management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel classes as necessary. **NO DOGS ALLOWED even on a leash.**
